2. INTRODUCTION:

The department of Economics originally was single-man department as student strength was negligible in 1983. The founder teacher for the department was Dr. Swabera Islam who continued to hold the post of head of department till 2012. With increased need Late Jitu Medhi joined the department subsequently and upon his resignation in mid 1989 Dr. Jayoshree Dam Paul Choudhury joined as faculty member in Sept, 1989; later on Dr. Upasana Chakravarty and Dr. Deluwar Haque joined the department in 1997 & 2005 respectively. After retirement of Dr. Swabera Islam in 2012, Dr. Ananta Pegu joined as Assistant Professor in 2016 and Ms. Rupali Talukdar (Gold Medalist) upon resignation of Dr. Deluwar Haque joined as faculty member of the department in September, 2018. After the retirement of Dr. Jayoshree Dam Paul Choudhury on October,2019, Ms Nitu Moni Bora joined the department as an assistant professor on 29th January, 2021. Further, Rupali Talukdar resigned from her post on February,2020 and to meet the demand of increasing number of classes, Ms Barnali Saikia was appointed (on contractual basis) on 15th February,2021 and is serving the department till date.

The department has consistently shown good result over the years especially for H.S. from 2014 onwards and for degree students also there is positive outcome and it is expected that in near future there will be an overall improvement as faculty members are committed to give their best service towards the growth of the department. As such the department got the opportunity to open Honors course along with B.Sc. Regular course from the session 2020-21 onwards.
