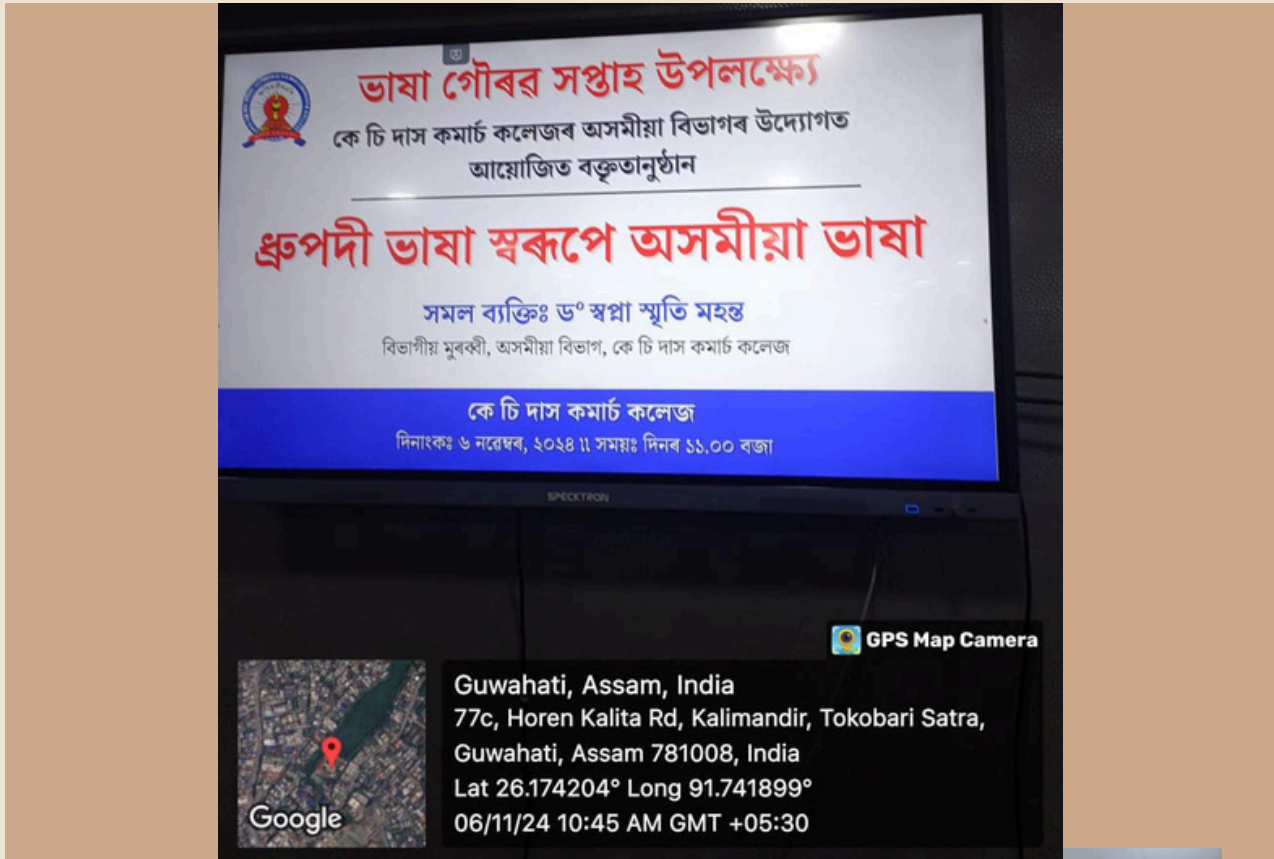
As part of the observance of "Bhasha Gaurav Week" (November 3–9, 2024), initiated by the Government of Assam, the Department of Assamese at K.C. Das Commerce College organized a lecture on "Assamese Language as a Classical Language" on 6th November 2024. The keynote address was delivered by Dr. Swapna Smriti Mahanta, Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Assamese. The programme commenced with an inaugural speech by the Principal, Dr. Hrishikesh Baruah, who underscored the significance of Assamese being granted the status of a classical language and urged all to take pride in this recognition.

In her lecture, Dr. Mahanta elaborated on various important themes including the origin and evolution of the Assamese language, its chronological development, the conferment of classical language status, and the broader importance of language preservation.

Following the lecture, Dr. Hrishikesh Baruah, along with Dr. Shrabani Bhadra, Dr. Prarthana Baruah, and Ms. Purnima Singh, shared their insights and reflections on the topic. The programme also featured a poetry recitation by Mr. Debasish Buragohain, Assistant Professor in the Department of Assamese.

The event concluded with the rendition of the Axom Sangeet, and witnessed active participation from over a hundred students along with faculty members of the college.



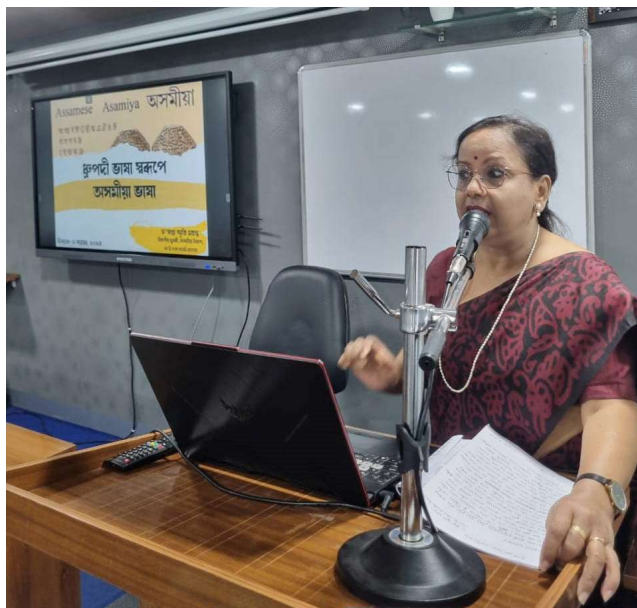
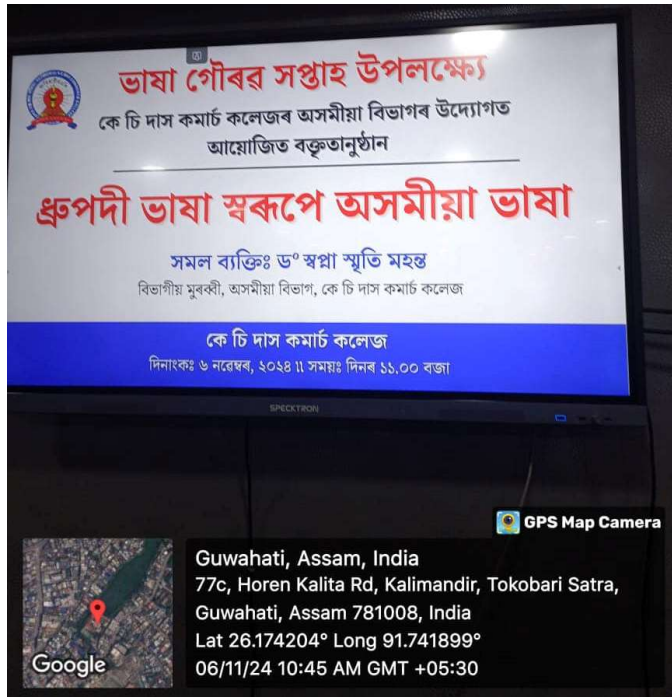
