

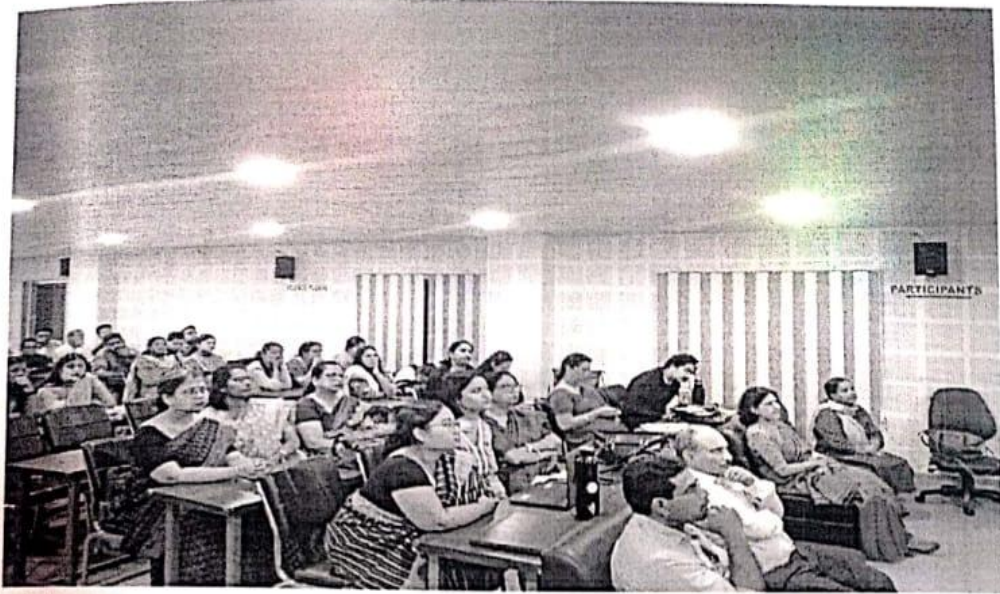

Das Commerce College. The head of the department of Economics Dr. Upasana Chakravarty, in her welcome address talked about the key points of the Assam Budget 2025-26. Dr Chakravarty believes that the budget is a welfare-oriented one that covers the areas**

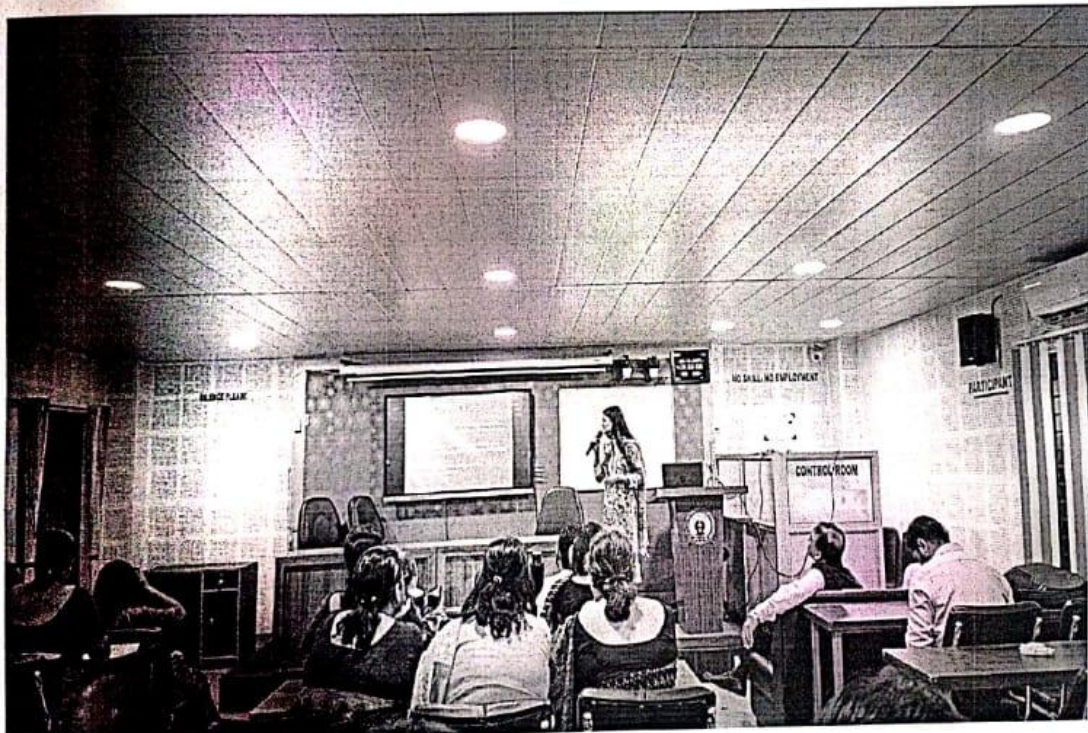

In his speech he emphasized that the budget basically focuses on boosting consumption of the masses and provide financial aid to the marginalized section for their better upliftment.
