


9. Outcome of the Event: On 6th March 2026, the Department of Economics of K. C. Das Commerce College, Guwahati organized a field survey on “Rubber Plantation in Assam: Problems and Prospects” at Sonapur, Kamrup (M). Students and teachers visited the plantation area and trekked about 3 km to observe the rubber fields. During the visit, the local cultivators shared valuable information about rubber cultivation and its process. They explained that rubber trees require suitable climatic conditions and it generally takes about 8 years for a rubber tree to become fully mature. After maturity, the latex (liquid rubber) is collected through a tapping process, and the collection can continue for around 8–9 months in a year depending on weather conditions. The survey helped students understand the practical aspects of plantation agriculture and the importance of rubber in providing employment and income to rural people. However, farmers also face problems such as price fluctuations, high initial investment, and climatic risks. Overall, the field survey was very informative and helped students gain practical knowledge about the cultivation, challenges, and future prospects of rubber plantation in Assam.


